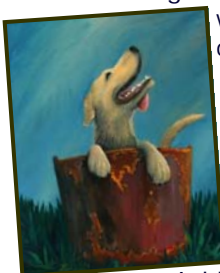

On Saturday, May 1, the [SPCA of Central Florida](#) hosted the 19th annual FurBall at SeaWorld Orlando.

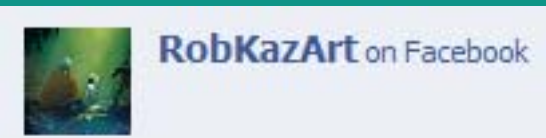
